PROF. CARLO COLOSIMO



Carlo Colosimo is currently chairman at the Department of Neurology, Santa Maria University Hospital of Terni, Italy.

Prof. Colosimo graduated from the Medical School of the Catholic University in Rome, Italy. After undertaking residency in neurology at the same University, he has been a post-doctoral research fellow in movement disorders at the National Hospital for Neurology in London, UK. He has served as consultant neurologist and professor at the Department of Neurology and Psychiatry, Sapienza University of Rome from 1993 to 2015. In this capacity, he has been involved in several trials concerning therapeutic agents for various neurological disorders and has contributed to the undergraduate and teaching programme of that department.

He is author of more than 250 original scientific papers, 170 of which in peer-reviewed international journals, and editor of two textbooks on movement disorders. He also serves as a manuscript reviewer for several journals and he was a member of the editorial board of the journal *Movement Disorders*; he currently serves in the editorial boards of *Parkinson disease* and *European Journal of Medical Research*. He is also co-editor of *Moving Along*, newsletter of the *Movement Disorders Society*. He is frequently invited to give lectures at major neurological congresses around the world.

Clinical research activity has been focused on Parkinson's disease and movement disorders, with particular interest in: infusion therapies for the management of advanced Parkinson's disease, use of different serotypes of botulinum toxin for the management of dystonia, genetic, epidemiological, and clinical aspects of atypical parkinsonian syndromes.
