Dr. Simon is an Associate Professor of Neurology at Harvard Medical School and Chief of the Movement Disorders Division at Beth Israel Deaconess Medical Center, as well as Director of their National Parkinson Foundation Center of Excellence. He is a member of the Parkinson Study Group Executive Committee and past Chair of the Scientific Review Committee and the Genetics and Environmental Risk Working Group. He has served on several multicenter clinical study Steering Committees, as well as on several NIH and foundation grant review committees. He is a member of the Editorial Board for *Annals of Neurology*, the Scientific Advisory Board for the Weston Brain Institute, and the Cure Parkinson Trust's "Linked Clinical Trials Committee". He also conducts laboratory research focusing on basic and translational research relating to mitochondrial dysfunction and neuroprotection in Parkinson's disease, with continuous NIH funding since 1997.
